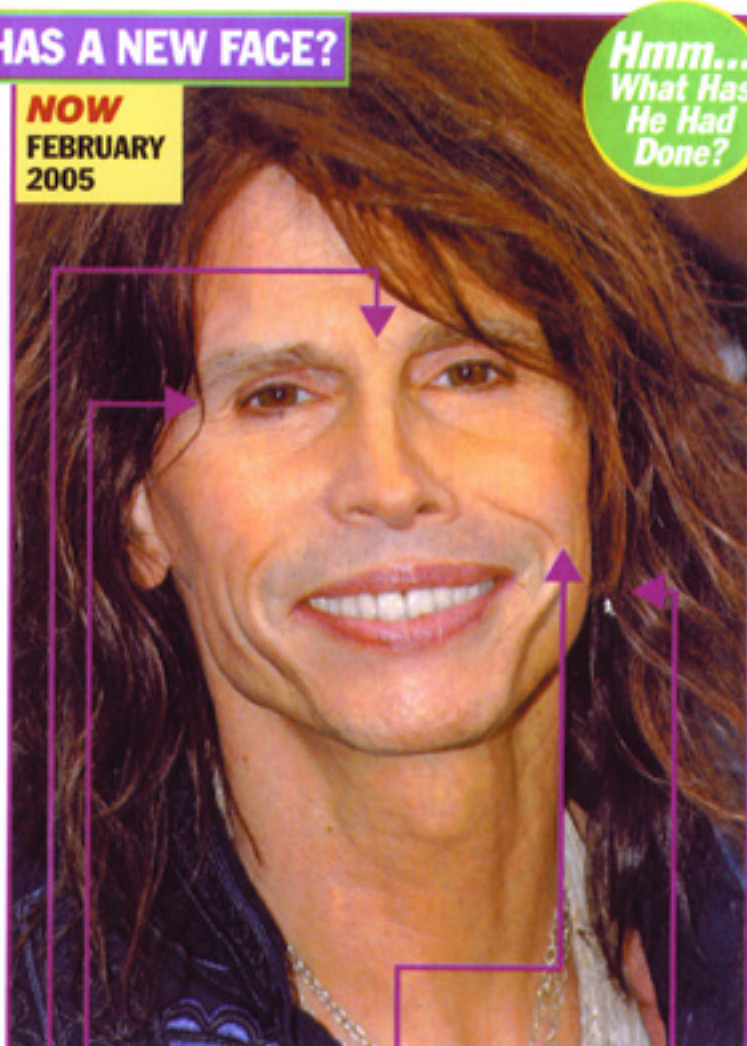
STEVEN TYLER: HAS A NEW FACE?

FILLERS?
"The deep frown line in between his brows is significantly improved," says Dr. Saadat, noting Tyler may use Botox or restilin. Under the eye and cheek areas, fat or collagen could be helping him reverse lines.

MESOGLOW?
Tyler's Grammy glow might be the result of a new injectable treatment called Mesoglow, says Dr. Saadat. "It plumps up skin and gives instant radiance," he says of this mix of Hyaluronic acid, vitamins and Retin-A.

CHEMICAL PEEL?
Tyler's taut skin is most likely the result of a chemical peel, possibly paired with laser-light therapy, says Dr. Newman. "This helps with the thin skin under the eyes, and the rest of the complexion."
